Deaf Smith is a stud, he is big topped, stout quartered, smooth shouldered and one of the most attractive sons of Ambush 28 we have seen to date. His EPD profile is dominant as well, ranking in the top 1% for Marbling and \$Beef while still maintaining the top 10% for WW, YW, CW, \$Feedlot and \$Grid. This one has A.I. stud quality written all over him.
